### CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL CALLED MEETING MINUTES

#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Owens called the meeting to order at 3:21 p.m.

#### 2. ROLL CALL

City Clerk Hiott conducted the roll call. Absent: Councilmembers Jeffcoat and Ferguson

#### 4. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

#### 5. OATH OF OFFICE ADMINISTERED TO COUNCILMEMBERS ELECT MICHAEL MCNEELY (DISTRICT 2) AND CASSANDRA BROWN (DISTRICT 4) AND RE-ELECTED COUNCILMEMBER DEBORA HERNDON (DISTRICT 6) - CHIEF JUDGE CHE A. KAREGA II

Mableton Chief Judge Che A. Karega II administered the Oath of Office to Councilmembers Elect, Michael McNeely and Cassandra Brown. Mayor Owens administered the Loyalty Oath to Councilmembers Elect, Michael McNeely and Cassandra Brown.

(Clerk's Note: The outgoing Councilmembers' terms expired Monday November 17, 2025, pursuant to Charter Section 5.11(g), which provides: "Except for the initial election of the mayor and city council, the terms of office of the mayor and councilmembers shall begin on the Monday following such person's election which is at least five days following the certification of the results of such person's election to such office unless a petition to contest" is filed.)

Chief Judge Che A. Karega II administered the Oath of Office and Mayor Owens administered the Loyalty Oath to Councilmember Herndon, who ran unopposed in the

November 4, 2025 election.

Mayor Owens and Councilmember Davis and Herndon welcomed the new councilmembers and expressed their excitement to work with them.
